

Town of Meredith Ordinance No. 1 of 2008
Establishing an Interim Application Process for Wireless
Telecommunications Facilities

BE IT ENACTED by the Town of Meredith as follows:

Section 1. A ninety (90) day Interim Application Process, effective upon the date of adoption of this local ordinance

(a) There is hereby enacted a ninety (90) day Interim Application Process for the issuance of permits by the Town of Meredith on applications for the construction of wireless telecommunications towers, facilities and related facilities.

(b) During the pendency of the adoption of a revised Local Law, applications for a building permit, special use permit or site plan approval, or other necessary Town approval for a monopole, lattice tower or other telecommunications antennae installations, including, but not limited to cellular/PCS antennae installations, shall be accepted and processed by the Town.

(c) In initiating an application during the period of this Interim Application Process, any applicant must submit an initial escrow deposit of \$6,000 against an ultimate escrow amount not to exceed two (2%) percent of the total cost of the proposed project, to cover any consulting costs incurred by the Town in evaluating the application, and further, if a permit is issued it will be issued pursuant to the terms of the revised Local Law. Any unexpended balance of the deposit shall promptly be returned to the applicant at the conclusion of the application process

Section 2. Effective Date: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Town Board and expire ninety (90) days thereafter.
